This booklet has been created for people to use as a way of exploring the Christian faith with non-churched friends and family. It does not speak in what we often label as 'christianese', you know all those big words like, propitiation, redemption, sanctification, salvation and 'being saved' (being saved from what, a non-churched person may well ask). Instead it focuses on love.

It has been observed that Uniting Church people are very reluctant to speak to others about our relationship with and love for God. This reluctance may be a knee jerk rection to the way evangelism was done in the past, with a heavy emphasis on accepting Jesus as Lord and Saviour in order to escape eternal torment in the fiery pit of hell. Where is the good news in that? A far better story, a story that is all good news is the story of God's love for us.

The problems the church faces in this rapidly changing world are complex and no one really knows what the church will look like in the decades to come but there is one thing we can do to ensure we remain vital, Spirit empowered and ready to adapt, and that is to fully comprehend, to know deep in our guts, that God loves us, unconditionally and without limitation.

God loves you who are feeling the aches and pains of aging, God loves you who like to remain in the background, God loves you who are loud and gregarious, God loves you who are not sure why you are in church today, God loves you who feel worthy, God loves you who feel worthless, and God loves you even if you have convinced yourself that you are unlovable.
