
Garage Sale Trail

Gail's Message

A friend of mine sent me an Irish blessing during the week including the following link which I have included here, if you would like to watch it: https://youtu.be/aTWEz698T1E

The above link leads you to a recording of the blessing performed by actress Roma Downey the star of TV series *Touched by an Angel*, which aired between 1994 and 2003. I spent some time googling Roma's career on the internet and discovered that in each episode of the show there would be a moment when a character would cry out to God for help, the cast called it the 'Angel Revelation' scene. At that point Roma or her fellow angel played by Della Reese would reveal their true nature as the agents of God sent from heaven. Roma and Della would pray before these scenes asking for God's grace and compassion to reach out to people watching the show.

Roma recounts that once she was once mistaken for her angel character 'Monica' in the children's ward of her local hospital. A woman cried with relief and hugged her, explaining that she had been praying for an angel to turn up. Instead of explaining the misidentification, Roma hugged the woman with compassion and prayed with her. When Roma told Della that this woman had thought her an angel, Della wisely replied, 'to that woman in need you were an indeed an angel'.

Roma's story makes me realise that as believer's we all have a calling to be like an angel to those in need of compassion, acts of kindness, prayer, and words of hope.

Roma's Irish Blessing contains the following line: May the Light of the Lord shine from your eyes, Like a candle in the window, Welcoming the weary traveller.
